Sun Moon Lake Tour - with meal (VTXG-1C)

Duration: approx. 9 hours (include travelling time) Price: HK\$560 per Adult, HK\$540 per Child

PARTICIPANTS REQUIRED: MIN. 30 PAX & MAX. 600 PAX

- <u>Lake cruise on Sun Moon Lake</u> the biggest fresh water lake in Taiwan, to come close to the natural beauty of the lakes and mountains, the best way to do this is by boat.
- Xuanguang Temple Journey to the West is a classic Chinese novel featuring monk Xuanzang's journey to the west to study Buddhism. Monk Xuanzang was the Holy Monk in the Tang dynasty. Going up the staircase from the Xuanguang temple pier you will see green plums lining along the way on both sides of the staircase. Climbing up to the temple you will see the distant Lalu island and breathe fresh air of the land of best fengshui.
- Wenwu Temple (outside visit) the architecture of the temple has the palace style of northern China. It is a large and imposing structure, with three separate halls. Another interesting feature is the two vermillion stone lions on the two sides of the front plaza.
- Shuishe Sun Moon Lake's vehicle transfer area, it is also the location of a famous scenic commerce street.
- Paper Dome Paper Dome is a temporary church building constructed using paper tubes as structural elements. It was designed on a pro-bono basis by Shigeru Ban, internationally known Japanese architect who is renowned for his paper tube structures and buildings. This temporary structure was built on September 17, 1995 to serve as a temporary church for Takatori Catholic Church after the Great Hanshin Earthquake.
- Lunch at local restaurant.

Lugang Tour – with meal (VTXG-2C)

Duration: approx. 9 hours (include travelling time)

- Lugang Folk Arts Museum established in 1973, with all the buildings, land, furniture, utensils and collector's items having been donated by the Koo family and other private benefacstors. The museum holds more than 6,000 articles. Fascinating household, travel, and recreational items, as well as religious implements and celebratory artifacts are displayed for visitors. The museum has a strong local flavour on itself. The architecture of the museum and the pieces housed within not only demonstrate the craftsmanship of the forefathers, but also attest to the thriving Lugang of old.
- Lugang Tianhou Temple one of the three major historic sites in Lugang. The temple is sublime and solemn and has elegant murals and paintings. The historic materials preserved here are valuable.
- Lugang Old Street this street is made up of the curved, red-tiled lanes of today's Putou, Yaolin, and Dayou streets. Both sides of the streets are lined with newly renovated old-style shop buildings that feature intensely interesting internal room layouts and old-style exteriors. Here you can feel some of the atmosphere of old Lugang.
- Great Buddha Statue of Bagua Mountain an impressive statue of the Buddha sits on a hillside park overlooking the small city of Changhua. Visitors can view the nearby area through the eyes of the 86-foot-high hollow statue.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
