Kagoshima City & Shopping Tour - without meal (QKOJ-1CA)

- **Sengan-en** – also known as Isoteien, is a Japanese style landscape garden along the coast north of downtown Kagoshima. One of the garden's most striking features is its use of Sakurajima and Kagoshima Bay as borrowed scenery. The garden also includes small ponds, streams, shrines and a bamboo grove.
- **Shiroyama Observatory** – The Shiroyama Park is most famous for its Shiroyama Observatory with spectacular views over downtown Kagoshima, Kagoshima Bay and Sakurajima.
- **Terukuni Shrine** – The most important shrine in Kagoshima city. Terukuni Shrine was rebuilt after being damaged in the final battle of the Satsuma Rebellion, "Saigo's Last Stand", but the current structures date from the post-World War II reconstruction following air raid damage. Perhaps the most distinctive feature of the shrine is the huge tree pruned into the shape of a bird with outstretched wings. The reason for the shrine being so modern is that the kami enshrined here was the 28th Lord of Satsuma, Shimazu Nariakira, and he lived until 1858. (Takes about 20 steps up to the Shrine)
- **Tenmonkan** – it is one of the city's main shopping and entertainment districts in Kagoshima. There are retail stores, boutiques, restaurants selling traditional Kagoshima food, café, and so on, lining the Tenmonkan arcade.
- **AEON Mall** - It is a supersize commercial establishment, with a floor area of 50,000sqm consists of over 170 shops including fashion boutiques, sundry shops and restaurants.

Sakurajima Tour – without meal (QKOJ-2CA)

- **Sakurajima Arimura Observatory** - Sakurajima is one of Japan's most active volcanoes and the symbol of Kagoshima. The volcano smokes constantly, and minor eruptions often take place multiple times per day. Located in the middle of Kagoshima Bay, Sakurajima is the area's most prominent geographic feature, having an elevation of 1117 meters and a circumference of about 50 kilometers. Before a powerful eruption in 1914, Sakurajima used to be an island in the bay, but the massive lava flow from that eruption created the volcano's current land connection to the Osumi Peninsula in the east. The Arimura Observatory gives a view onto Sakurajima's craters from a slight elevation of about 75 meters. (Takes about 40 steps up to the Observatory)
- **Sakurajima Foot Hot Spring Experience** - The Sakurajima Yogan Nagisa Park has a 100-metre-long foot hot spring. With Kinko Bay in front and the magnificent Mount Sakurajima behind, one can feel the energy of mother nature. Immerse your tired feet in the natural hot spring water discharged from 1,000 metres underground, to recuperate from fatigue.
- **Tenmonkan** – it is one of the city's main shopping and entertainment districts in Kagoshima. There are retail stores, boutiques, restaurants selling traditional Kagoshima food, café, and so on, lining the Tenmonkan arcade.
- **Sengan-en** – also known as Isoteien, is a Japanese style landscape garden along the coast north of downtown Kagoshima. Its large, beautiful buildings are surrounded by forest and have been declared important cultural property. (Takes about 40 steps up to the Shrine)
- **Kirishima Hot Springs Experience** - Kirishima Hot Springs lies on the lower slopes of the Kirishima Mountains with a distant view over Kagoshima Bay and Sakurajima. It is one of Japan's leading hot springs resorts with high quality, sulfuric hot spring waters and an interesting variety of outstanding bath facilities.
- **Lunch** at local restaurant
- **Takachiho Ranch** – The ranch has been called a place where one can truly be refreshed while surrounded by nature. Here you can also enjoy the magnificent view of Kagoshima.
- **Masarujō** – where you can find Kagoshima local products including Japanese wine, noodles, tea, as well as souvenirs.

Nagasaki Historical Tour – without meal (QNGS-1CA)

Duration: approx. 5.5 hours (include travelling time)

PARTICIPANTS REQUIRED: MIN. 40 PAX & MAX. 800 PAX

- **Glover Garden** – an open air museum, exhibiting mansions of former Western residents of Nagasaki. It is located on the hill where Western merchants settled down after the end of Japan's era of seclusion in the second half of the 19th century. A nice panorama of the city can be enjoyed from the garden.
- **Oura Catholic Church (outside photo stop)** - it is the Nagasaki's oldest Catholic church, designed by French priest at end of Edo period and completed during early meiji era. Only western-style structure to be listed as national treasure.
- **Hamacho shopping street** – It is one of the biggest Shopping Street in Nagasaki with about 700 shops around the areas. Here you will find Department Stores, home appliance shops, cosmetic shops, drug stores and restaurants.
- **Nagasaki Peace Park** - commemorates the atomic bombing of Nagasaki. In the park stand the massive Peace Statue as well as various other memorials.
- **Ground Zero** – a monument around a black pillar marks the atomic explosion's epicentre.

Unzen Jigoku Tour – with meal (QNGS-2C)

- **Unzen Jigoku** – The area between Koyu and Shinyu covered in white soil (solfataric soil) is the Unzen Jigoku area. In Buddhist teachings, Jigoku (hell) is where people are punished for their evil deeds that they committed in the past life. With extremely high temperature hot springs and gasses erupting from everywhere, among the strong smell of sulfur and billowing steam, indeed conjures images of the fearsome Jigoku.
- **Obama Foot Hot Springs Experience** - Hot springs can be seen flowing from the southwest of Takaku Peak. Even today, it boasts the hottest springs in Japan, with the 30 springs throughout the town producing over 15,000 tons of water per day that can reach temperatures as high as 105°C.
- **Lunch** at local restaurant.
- **Hamacho shopping street** – It is one of the biggest Shopping Street in Nagasaki with about 700 shops around the areas. Here you will find Department Stores, home appliance shops, cosmetic shops, drug stores and restaurants.
